

## **AKC Housekeeping & Waste Disposal**

**Dear Residents** - Did you know that it is a condition of your tenancy to dispose of waste using trash bins and dumpsters?

Recently there has been an increase in improper waste disposal, including:

- disposing of trash bags outside of waste bins instead of inside them
- dumping of household items and furniture outside accommodations
- leaving food waste in common areas for stray animals
- dumping of moving and packaging waste in public areas



This behavior results in unpleasant odor, attracts rodents and stray cats, and is not a pleasant sight for residents and visitors. Strong winds can also spread waste over a larger area affecting others and creating road hazards.



We work hard to create a safe and comfortable environment so that you and your family enjoy living in Al Khor Community. We must enforce all terms and conditions of our leases. Therefore, we urge all residents to dispose all garbage properly.

Littering in public areas is a serious antisocial act and is not in compliance with the community's regulations. If this attitude does not improve, we will inform the HR department about behavioral issue and implement disciplinary actions.

### ***What can you do?***

- In case you are uncertain over proper disposal procedure in the Community, contact AKC Helpdesk at 44734555 and ask for a Housing or Environment representative.
- If you see anyone violating waste disposal & housekeeping rules or polluting the AKC environment, please report them to AKC Security on 4472 4001.
- Alternatively, if you see an overflowing dumpster that needs emptying, please call Housing on 4473 4512, who will inform our landlord Alaqaria to take necessary action.
- In case you are planning change your furniture and are in need to dispose of bulky waste contact our Housing department for advice.

### ***AKC Code of Conduct & AKC Behavioral Rules state:***

#### **9. Public Areas**

- a. Graffiti and littering are prohibited. Every resident is responsible of maintaining good housekeeping of his unit and the surrounding area.
